PETITION TO APPOINT CURATOR

Petitioner, Lynne Marley Baker, alleges:

1. Petitioner has an interest in the above estate as the wife, and appointed personal representative of the decedent, Lynn Edward Baker. Petitioner's name and address are set forth in paragraph 3 and the name and office address of his or her attorney are set forth at the end of this petition.

2. Decedent Lynn Edward Baker, whose last known address was 5965 Ashford Lane, Naples, FL 34110, and, if known, whose age was 74 and the last four digits of whose social security number is xxx-xx-2691, died on March 26, 2022, and on the date of death, decedent was domiciled in Collier County, State of Florida.

6. Petitioner requests that the court appoint a Curator *sua sponte* due to the nature of the assets, particularly the business organizations in the decedent's name and membership interests. There is strong reason to believe that significant portions of the funds managed and held by the decedent's business organizations do not belong to the estate but to third parties, requiring neutral management of a curator.

The Estate and Personal Representative have assets that are the owned by the decedent's estate and the Personal Representative requests the professional expertise of a curator in order to facilitate the transfer of ownership/membership of the respective entities. The curator is appropriate in this matter pursuant to Fla. Stat. §733.501.

Petitioner requests that the court appoint a curator *sua sponte* of the estate of the decedent to address the ownership/membership interests of the decedent, beneficiaries, and/or third parties.
